

Scuola Politecnica di Design confirms partnership with Volkswagen for its Master course in Transportation and Car Design 2010-2011 and signs five-year collaboration agreement.

A partnership for the education of young creatives choosing Milan for their advanced training in the design of the future mobility.



Scuola Politecnica di Design SPD Milan and Volkswagen are extending their collaboration. The Milan-based design school already has experienced several partnerships with several brands of the group, including Audi and Lamborghini and has now signed a five-year collaboration with Volkswagen regarding didactic experimentation. Starting October 2010, Volkswagen and SPD will promote together the development of research projects on future mobility, assigned to the students of the SPD Master course in Transportation and Car Design.

The opportunities offered by this collaboration between a solid educational institution and the most important group of the automotive branch consist in scholarships for the Master course as well as internships for selected students.

The Master is composed of workshops, theory lessons and integrated courses in order to offer a rich knowledge in project development, able to prepare the students for their professional life. The multidisciplinary course also focuses on virtual and real modelling and gives the students the opportunity to get in touch with the designers of the Research and Design Centre of Volkswagen Group, who will support the professors of SPD, coordinated by Andreas Zapatinas, with the development of the different subjects of the research topics.

The briefing, to be assigned to the students, will be defined together with the responsible designers of Volkswagen Group and will have an imprint of experimentation and innovation, not linked to producibility.

The upcoming season of Master courses at Scuola Politecnica di Design SPD starting October 2010 will be participated by young and talented creatives from all over the world. The course is open to graduates in Industrial Design, Architecture, Engineering or equivalents or candidates with significant background in the sector. Admission is subject to an analysis of the candidate's curriculum vitae and portfolio. Lectures are held in English.
